## Brevard Achievement Center's Hittin' the Road For New Annual Fundraiser

A Checkered Flag Finish and Celebration at 6 p.m. in the RCC ballroom will cap the day's events. The Celebration will feature food, libations and a fantastic silent auction. Car clubs with both vintage and modern cars also will be on display outside the Club.
